Motion activated light/camera assemblies can be used to replace existing exterior lights found on garages or sides of house. Cameras/Lights on either side of garage will be carriage type, which complements the community. Light cannot focus on or interfere with neighboring properties or street. All wiring must be concealed or installed in a conduit. All mounting hardware and conduit must be painted to match the color of the adjacent surface. Cameras cannot be attached to the house's architectural features or shutters. Requires a City of Lincoln Building Permit if hardwired

The timeline for completion of work is within 90 calendar days from the start of work and

must be completed before the one-year approved application period expires.
